Rules/Guidelines

The Youth Tour Awards are given to two students on the basis of a competitive true/false examination testing their general knowledge about electric cooperatives, the application & achievement form, and a brief interview.

- The examination and interviews will be conducted on Thursday, March 9, at Washington Electric Cooperative's office at 440 Highland Ridge Road near Marietta. Students who are selected for an interview will be informed of their interview appointment at a later date.
- Applicants must be a high school sophomore or junior whose parent(s) or legal guardian(s) are a member of Washington Electric Cooperative, Inc. and must be presently living in a home receiving electric service from Washington Electric Cooperative, Inc.
- Completed application must be received in the office of Washington Electric Cooperative, Inc. on or before <u>February 10, 2023</u>.
