Washington Electric Cooperative receives a high volume of tree-related requests each year. To help us evaluate your concern, please complete this form before any assessment or work can be considered.

How the Process Works

Submitting this form requests an assessment by Washington Electric Cooperative personnel of one or more trees near power lines on your property. Cooperative personnel will determine whether the trees pose a safety hazard or outage risk and whether trimming or removal is the cooperative's responsibility.

Signing this form does not guarantee that the tree(s) will be trimmed or removed.

Cleanup and Responsibility

If the cooperative performs trimming or removal work, the member/property owner is responsible for cleanup and disposal of all tree debris, including limbs, brush, logs, and stumps, unless otherwise stated by the cooperative.

Scheduling

Tree requests are handled as quickly as possible; however, response times may vary depending on workload, weather conditions, emergencies, and the severity of the situation.
